Cremation Options at a Glance

5. Traditional/Contemporary Service Followed by Cremation

5160

A full service at a hall, church, or Heritage North, followed by cremation.

6. Cremation with Celebration of Life

3690

Time for family members and friends to gather at Heritage North with the urn present, and photos and memorabilia displayed. Family and friends can reminisce with others, coffee and tea provided.

7. Attendance at Crematory

3505

Family and friends gather at the crematorium for a reading, to play a song, or say a few words, before the start of the cremation.

8. Cremation Service

3350

Basic cremation service provided to family /friends. A reading is offered by Heritage North staff.

Specialty Cremation Service may result in limited options and additional fees.

Note: Embalming is not required by law but may be necessary dependent upon the services selected.

1. Administrative and Operational Fee	1500
This is a basic fee that we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences. It includes a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses required to serve the public with 24 hour on call staff. This charge also includes, but is not limited to, consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, preparation of documents for attending physician or coroner and Vital Statistics, obtaining necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory, common carrier and assistance with other documentation.	
2. Transfer of Decedent to or From Heritage North (within 40 km local service area)	
a) Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.	415
b) Evenings, weekends, and holidays (415 + additional 120 per staff involved)	535
c) Loading of decedent during normal business hours. Includes staff to assist with loading of decedent, use of equipment as requested and available and casket shipping crate to cover casket	395
d) All travel outside local service area. (1.30 to 1.80 per km for transfer vehicle / 2.75 to 3.30 per km for coach)	205
3. Minimum Sanitation	205
This is required by Heritage North in all cases for public health and safety of attending personnel.	
4. Sheltering Room	505
Provision of sanitary room for monitoring human remains. Excessive delays will incur additional fees.	
5. Other Care of Decedent	400
This includes but is not limited to bathing, dressing, setting features to a natural repose, cosmetics, and casketing.	
a) Dressing and casketing	155
b) Setting features only with a visitation	205
6. Embalming	640
Embalming autopsied case (640 + additional 460).....	1100
7. Bioseal	640
Provision of a hermetically sealed liner for a casket in cases without embalming or with shipment.	
8. Facilities for Viewing, Visitation, Service or Reception	
a) Facility for visitation, service or reception (up to 2 hours, includes coffee and tea service) ...During business hours.....	160/hr
	After hours220/hr
9. Direction of Memorial Services	340
Services of director and assistants as required. Setting up prior to service, use of necessary equipment, caring for and arranging floral tributes, attending to guests, attending to guest book and condolence cards.	
a) Services in evening or on weekend or holiday (340 + additional 650)	990
b) Graveside service / Witnessed cremation	155
c) Graveside service: evening, weekend, or holiday (155 + additional 210)	350
10. Cremation Fee	930
a) Rush Cremation: evening, weekend, or holiday (930 + additional 425).....	1355
11. Automotive Equipment (within 40 km local service area)	
a) Coach and driver	275
b) Passenger vehicle (6) and driver	215
